The individual will work closely with the Island Services Superintendent on daily operations and will partner with the Head Golf Professional/Golf Pro on all issues related to golf course maintenance, ensuring quality standards are met.

The ideal candidate will have: an Associate or Bachelors degree in Horticulture, Golf Course and Turf Management, or related field; Golf Course Superintendents Association of America (GCSAA) certification, preferred; and five years' experience in golf course maintenance, with three years supervisory experience. Experience with Bermuda Grass, Bent Grass, and Site-Pro automated irrigation, preferred. Current Maryland Drivers License required with good driving record. Ability to secure Pesticide Application license. Strong customer service philosophy and communication skills. Knowledge of management and maintenance of greens, fairways and roughs; knowledge of irrigation patterns, drainage, and construct tees and/or greens.
