Assistant in Training Position

Club Description: Bidermann Golf Course is a small, private, member-owned facility for the Vicmead Hunt Club opened for play in 1965, designed by Dick Wilson. We have 3 acres of A1/ A4 greens, 2.5 acres of tees and 27 acres of fairways. The golf course property encompasses a total of 300 acres and is described as a “meadowland course” with native fescue areas separating each hole. The course averages 9,000 rounds per year.

Short-term projects for our staff includes completion of the fairway bunkers, comprehensive tee leveling and additions, coinciding with 2016 Master Plan.

In the fall of 2017 the Club will break ground on a multi-million-dollar Operations Center that will include staffing areas, plant management building, storage barns, closed loop recycled wash area.

Position Description: The successful candidate will work within a team environment, love the game of golf, possess goals for making a future impact in the realm of golf course management and above all, a willingness to have fun while working.

Experience Requirements: The ideal candidate would have completed at least one or more internships. The candidate should have some experience in irrigation management, fertilization and application of plant protection products. This is an entry level assistant position and we are willing to train the correct individual for our operation.

Educational Requirements: Four or two-year degree or certificate in Turfgrass Management or similar field.

Compensation: This is an hourly position that will include overtime. The candidate can expect the yearly monetary range in the upper thirties to mid-forties, depending upon overtime requirements.

Benefits: This is a full-time, year round position: golf privileges; uniforms; meals; medical and dental; 401K (after one year of employment); ten vacation days; ten holidays. We will also provide opportunities to volunteer at PGA, LPGA and USGA events.
